Prizes

The competitor returning the lowest scratch medal score over 18 holes will hold the Trophy for one Year. Additional prizes will be awarded for:- (no player shall win more than one prize)

- 2nd and 3rd place gross
- 1st 2nd and 3rd place net
- Best female gross & best female net (dependent on number of entries)

Conditions

1. The competition will be played over 18 holes of medal play on the Palmerston Course, in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of the Club. The decision of the Competition Committee will be final.
2. The competition is open to male and female amateur golfers who are members of an affiliated golf club. Open to boys with a handicap not exceeding **12** and girls with a handicap not exceeding **18** under the current Scratch Score and handicapping scheme of C.O.N.G.U. The competition will be a qualifying competition for handicapping purposes.
3. **Competitors must be aged under 18 at 0.00hrs on 1st January 2010.**
4. Entries will be limited to 90, in the event of this limit being exceeded, there will be a ballot for places, with a reserve list provided. The Competition Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry without reason. **ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY NO LATER THAN FRIDAY 10th JULY** on the completed entry form below, with a cheque for the Entry Fee of **£25.00** made payable to **Brocket Hall International Limited**. Refunds will not be given after the draw has been made and no substitute can be found.
5. In the event of a tie for the trophy the winner will be decided by the standard countback method.
6. **Practice rounds are permitted weekdays and weekend days after 2.00pm at £20 each and should be booked through the golf shop on 01707 368739. All guests must sign the Visitors Book on arrival.**
7. The Entry Fee of £25.00 includes tea and coffee on arrival and buffet lunch on return to the Clubhouse, prize giving will be at 7.30pm approx.
8. Competitors are required to report to the relevant starting tees at least 5 minutes prior to their starting time, details of which will be posted to the address on the entry form as soon as possible after the closing date – Friday 10th July. Tee times will be between 11.30am and 2.30pm. The Competition Committee reserves the right to amend any starting times accordingly.
9. Competitors are informed that smart casual dress is in order all day and the **use of mobile phones is strictly forbidden within the Clubhouse and on the course.**
10. Finally, in the interest of all parties, competitors are expected to complete the full 18 holes, the estimated time for the round is 4 hours 10 minutes, except in exceptional circumstances where this is not possible.
